- Appropriate behaviour is expected at all times. Acts of yelling for the sake of being negative towards our youth and our officials will not be tolerated. General acts of displeasure, derogatory comments, confrontation and poor behaviour will not be accepted under any circumstances. We also need to ensure we treat our officials young and old with respect and dignity.

All cases of unacceptable behaviour will be dealt with by WVRA in the following manner.

- 1) Verbal intervention – cease and desist.
- 2) Possible Suspension up to and including be asked to step away from the program.
- 3) RCMP may be contacted in cases where a criminal offence has been committed.
