### Tom Hanson Coach of the Year Memorial Award

Western Valley Centre for Coaching Education renamed its Coach of the Year Award to "Tom Hanson Coach of the Year Memorial Award" in honor of a committee member who passed away in 2007.

Throughout the 1980's and 1990's under Tom's guidance, the Woodstock Rebels Softball Team excelled in on-field excellence and off-field sportsmanship. The ladies learned the finger points of the game and were encourages to coach and mentor newer players on the team.

In 1991, Tom received the Softball NB's Coach of the Year Award. Tom took an active role in the Provincial softball organization, advocating for women's softball. He pushed for the inclusion of the Women's Masters category of the Provincial play. In 2006, the Woodstock Rebels team was inducted to the Softball NB Wall of Fame.
